

RULES FOR LEIFUR EIRÍKSSON AIR TERMINAL

Art. 1

These rules apply to the Leifur Eiríksson Air Terminal together with its grounds and parking lots.

Art. 2

The public has free access to open areas, such as parking lots, check-in and arrival halls and waiting areas, connecting corridor and refreshment facilities.

Art. 3

All conduct which causes disturbance to others is prohibited. No person may harass another, nor behave in an indecent manner.

Art. 4

People must state their name and address and explain the purpose of their presence, when so required by police or security personnel, and must comply with their instructions.

Art. 5

All people must refrain from causing damage. Care shall be taken not to walk over or otherwise damage lawns, flower beds or hedges. It is prohibited to pick or uproot flowers and other vegetation.

Art. 6

Advertising is prohibited except by permission of ISAVIA Ltd.

Art. 7

The permission of ISAVIA Ltd. is required for all commercial activity, temporary or longer-term, including photography, car rental, and accommodation rental.

Art. 8

All staff in the Leifur Eiríksson Air Terminal must wear an identity card, which shall be clearly visible when at work, issued by ISAVIA Ltd. Security.

Art. 9

Other than in shops, sale of goods or services of any kind is prohibited, except by permission of ISAVIA Ltd.

Art. 10

Pets are prohibited, with the exception of police dogs and guide-dogs for the visually-impaired.

Art. 11


Police and security personnel may prohibit people from remaining in the building or on the grounds, if they deem them likely to cause disturbance or pose a risk. It is prohibited to be in the Terminal building between 20:00 and 05:00 unless necessity so requires. The public are prohibited from cooking food in the building or on the grounds.

Art. 12

Smoking is prohibited in the Terminal, except in specially-indicated areas.


